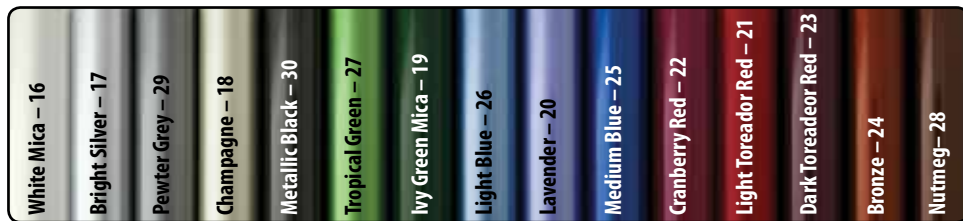

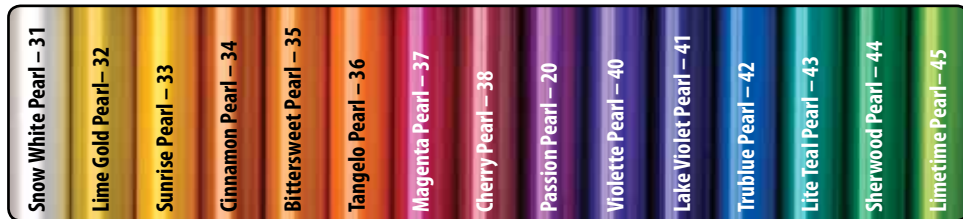
Metallic and Mica PPG Global System
